

Where and how can I dispose of bulky waste if I am unable to wait for the next collection?

There are four recycling centres in Lübeck which accept up to 3 m³ of bulky waste in return for a fee. For every half m³ of waste left at the centre, the fee totals 5.70 Euros.

What exactly is bulky waste?

If you move home or you carry out renovation work, you often find yourself with things you no longer need. They are things that need throwing away but due to either their size or weight, they do not fit into the household rubbish bins.

This includes, for instance:

✓ Floor coverings:

Carpets, flooring, linoleum- and PVC- floor covering, laminate. *Note:* Please roll these items up or bundle them together.

✓ Items of furniture:

Bedsteads, kitchen fittings (no electrical appliances), wardrobes, curtain fittings and pelmets, wooden shelf units, cupboards, blinds, slatted frames, mattresses, shelving, sofas, chairs, armchairs, tables, etc.

✓ Other items:

Garden furniture, suitcases, sledges, skis, sunshades, kids' buggies, bikes, cages and baskets for pets, plastic tubs, water butts, washing baskets, etc.



The following is NOT bulky waste:

Type of waste	Disposal method
Waste glass <i>Bottles and glasses</i>	Waste glass container
Old clothes / textiles <i>Clothes, shoes, curtains, bed spreads, cushions, blankets</i>	Old clothes container
Old medical products	Pharmacy or recycling centre
Waste from building work <i>Building waste, wall cladding, doors, windows, floorboards, railing, all kinds of fencing</i>	Small amounts → recycling centre, large amounts → container or e. g. Entsorgungszentrum Lübeck (EZL)
Sanitation fittings Bathtubs, radiators, bathroom fittings, WCs and basins	Small amounts → recycling centre, large amounts → container or e. g. EZL
Tree cuttings and garden refuse	Small amounts → Bio waste bin / bio waste sack available against payment from Entsorgungsbetriebe Lübeck (EBL), larger amounts → recycling centre
Electrical waste and electronic equipment <i>Cookers, fridges, TV sets, computers, hair driers, toasters etc.</i>	Can be disposed of free at charge at recycling centre, or can sometimes be collected/handed in free of charge by retailer
Smaller items <i>Broken toys, ceramic products, vases, old wallpaper</i>	General waste bin or general waste sack available against payment from EBL, or special collection and emptying of general waste bin against payment
Paper and cardboard <i>(auch Teppichpapprollen)</i>	Paper waste bin, collection container or recycling centre
Hazardous waste <i>Paints and varnishes, chemicals, household cleaners, solvents, wood creosotes, pesticides</i>	- In standard household amounts, free of charge at the recycling centre - Via hazardous waste collection service (1 x month in different areas of city) - Registration via bulky waste card, special date for collection provided

How do I register bulky waste?

To arrange for the collection of your bulky waste, you must provide the details of all the items (including their quantity) of which you would like to dispose. You will then be informed of your collection date in writing.

The bulky waste must then be left in a visible spot on the roadside outside your property (it must not be left on private land or on the driveway).

How many times can I register, and how long does it take until collection occurs?

Private households can register for up to 3 m³ of bulky waste to be collected free of charge twice a year. It is usually 3-4 weeks from the registration until the collection date.
